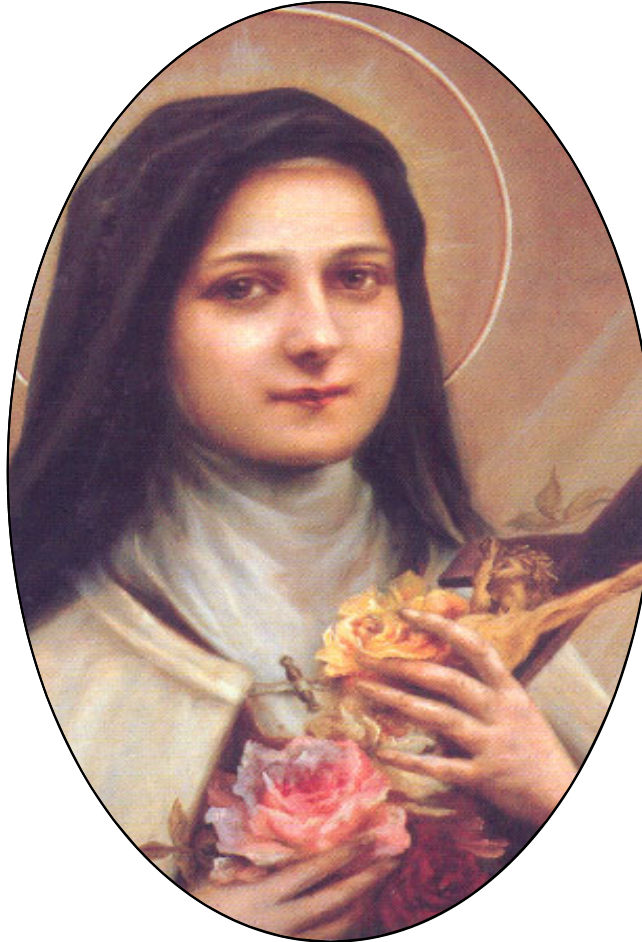

### Regulations for Fast and Abstinence

There are two days in Lent that are days of Fast and Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Fridays during Lent are days of Abstinence.

**Abstinence:** Catholics from age 14 are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and Fridays during Lent.

**Fasting:** Catholics ages 18-59 are obliged to fast from food on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The fast requires that a person eat the equivalent of less-than-two meals in place of the typical three meals eaten during the day.



**Perpetual Adoration Captains** meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 20th, beginning with a Mass at 12:00 Noon with meeting to follow. Everyone is welcome.

**Fish Fry Dinners:** Knights of Columbus Council 4286 at Christ the King in Belmont will have Fish Fry Dinners during Lent. The dinners will be held on Fridays, February 16 & 23, March 2, 9, 16 & 23 from 4-6:30 pm in Adrians Hall. Adults \$8.00 - Children 12 & under \$5.00.


**Knights of Columbus:** During the forty days of Lent, Knights will be conducting a program entitled "40 Cans For Lent". They are asking that all parish families/members/friends set aside one can of non-perishable food each day of Lent and place their food items in the large box in the wagon. At the end of each week, all cans will be given to the Cooperative Care Center.

**Anniversary Book:** The 25th-71st Anniversary Book committee is looking for group 1st Communion and Confirmation pictures over the last 25 years.
