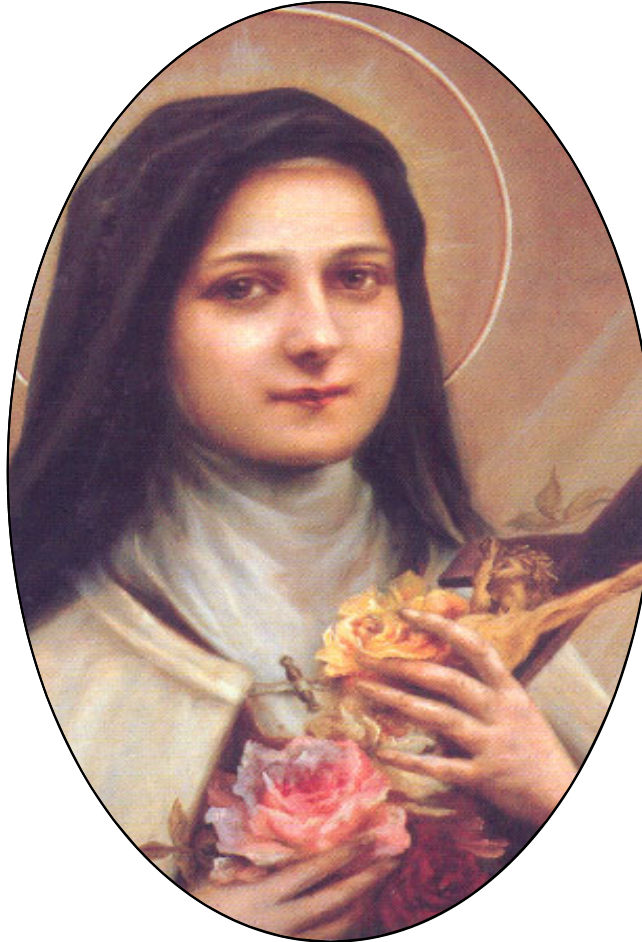

Knights of Columbus Breakfast will be held this **Sunday, March 25th**, from 8:00 am to 12:00 Noon in the Parish Hall.

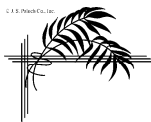
