Improvements, Repairs to Church Underway

Parishioners have noticed the new concrete stairs and walk leading from the parking lot to the side door of the chapel. This convenient and needed addition is credited to the hours of labor donated by the members of the Maintenance Committee.

A new roof, with a slightly different color, will appear on the church soon. An insurance claim has been approved to replace the current roof that had been damaged.



In the planning stage, is the enhancement of the tabernacle area with an oak wood design. Also, a new stain glass window will replace the round window over the tabernacle. The present window is warped and leaks moisture. The new window will echo the design on the tabernacle door with chalice, grapes and wheat.
